

Course Title:	Mossflower Wildschool Co-Curricular Enrichment Program
Course Description:	Wildschool co-ops accommodate kids ages 4 and up, and meet each week throughout the year (August – May). Weekly classes are themed with a variety of academic subjects and hands-on projects. Students’ participation in group activities are assessed throughout the semester by qualified instructors. In addition to weekly meetings, the instructors also plan field trips to local museums and educational programs in the local community.
Academic program:	Mossflower Wildschool co-op meetings feature lesson plans that include hands-on learning in a range of academic subjects, including: STEM, English Language Arts, fine arts and life skills.
Class Locations:	Yvonne Richardson Community Center (Fayetteville, AR) • Farmington Creekside Park (Farmington, AR) • Various educational field trip locations in NW Arkansas
Educational Goals and Skills:	Mossflower Wildschool centers on fostering connections with other local homeschooling families, encouraging learners to gain social skills and confidence. The program also aims to develop stronger academic skills, particularly in STEM, ELA, fine arts and life skills (such as cooking, sewing, budgeting/finance, etc).
Qualifications:	Mossflower Academy, LLC currently has three qualified and experienced instructors on staff for both local and in-person classes. Co-op instructor, Astrid Turner, is an experienced instructor with over 10 years of experience teaching both online and in-person classes for kids K-12. She has been operating the weekly co-op meetings since 2023.
Public School Alternatives:	The skills developed through the Mossflower Wildschool program are comparable to those offered in public schools; namely: • Providing opportunities for students to socialize and build friendships (peer-to-peer group interactions and team building games and sports provided daily in public schools). • Offering a wide range of academic subjects through use of hands-on projects and assignments (such as science fairs, spelling bees, afterschool clubs, etc).
